## FLOWER JUDGING TEAM IS A WINNER

The 1977 Colorado State University Flower Judging Team, sponsored by the Colorado Flower Growers' Association, Inc., placed second at the 36th Intercollegiate Flower Judging Contest held at Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana on March 28, 1977. Members of the team were Elizabeth Malm, senior from Fort Collins; Dianna Pund, senior from Cincinnati, Ohio; Niles Riese, junior from Colorado Springs; and alternate Janet Long, senior from Fort Collins. Twenty-three universities sent teams to compete in this year's contest, sponsored by SAF's Foundation for Floriculture and Pi Alpha Xi.

In the individual judging competition, Liz Malm, Colorado State University, was the high-scoring individual. Liz's total score was 2375 out of a possible 2500 points. She was also the top pot plant judge.

In the design competition, Janet Long, Colorado State University, was presented the first place award for her asymmetrical triangle design.
