

LIST OF PESTICIDES THAT HAVE THE "NOTIFY" STATEMENT ON THE LABEL

Below is a draft listing of pesticides that have Worker Protection Standard (WPS) worker double notification requiring both oral notice and posting. Please note that pesticides with a Danger/Poison signal word have the WPS worker double notification requirement - as may a few others.

you can look up the "worker double notification" requirement for each pesticide. Look for a yes or no answer to "P&O:" on the same line with the EPA registration number. (It is in Appendix III (pink pages) starting on page number F301.)

Please note that pesticides with a Danger/Poison signal word have the WPS worker double notification requirement - as may a few others.

Under WPS, employers are exempt from the worker notification requirement (including the double notification requirement) if ALL their workers employees are immediate family members (as defined by WPS). In this exemption case, no WPS posting would be required. If the label requires WPS worker double notification and an employer qualifies for the WPS exemption above, then, Minnesota state law still requires posting (following WPS posting guidelines). Exempted from this state posting requirement are soil applied insecticides.

MDA, CENEX/LOL Agronomy Division and I have started to revised the draft WPS label information guide as we did last year. As soon as it is finished (sometime in April) I will send out a copy to each county .

Three examples:

1) Counter is soil applied for corn rootworm control on a Minnesota farm. The Counter label requires WPS worker double notification. All WPS covered worker employees on the farm are immediate family members.

Does the field have to be posted? No. Exempt from both WPS and state posting requirements.

2) Counter is soil applied for corn rootworm control on a Minnesota farm. The Counter label requires WPS worker double notification. At least one WPS covered worker employee on the farm is not an immediate family member.

Does the field have to be posted? Yes. Not exempt from WPS double notification (oral notice and posting).

3) Furadan is foliar applied for European corn borer on a Minnesota farm. The Furadan label requires WPS worker double notification. All WPS covered worker employees on the farm are immediate family members.

Does the field have to be posted? Yes. Exempt from WPS but not state posting requirement.
