POTASSIUM DEFICIENCY IN MARGUERITE DAISIES

Practically all Marguerite daisy growers in San Mateo County have observed the yellowing (interveinal clorosis) that occurs on the foliage of yellow and white varieties. The symptoms are found mainly on the older leaves.

Dr. Roy Branson, Extension Soils and Water Specialist, and R. H. Sciaroni, Farm Advisor, have found that the potassium levels are quite low in leaves showing the symptoms.
